

Nomination Guide for 2026 Board of Directors

In order to run for office and serve, ALL candidates must be REALTORS® with Seattle King County REALTORS® in good standing. Members of the Board are expected to attend a three-hour meeting every other month and be engaged in other Association activities.

OPEN DIRECTOR AND OFFICER POSITIONS

Director-At-Large (2-Year Term) (4 positions to be elected)

Start your involvement with the Board in this position. Members in good standing are eligible to run.

Young Professionals Network Director (1-Year Term)

The Young Professionals Network (YPN) shall forward the name of one nominee for election each year. Must be an active YPN councilmember.

Regional Director (2-Year Term) (2 positions to be elected)

For this election cycle, the following positions will be elected:

- South County Region: ONE firm owner, or licensed managing broker, who holds decision-making authority within the real estate firm, as confirmed by the Nominations Committee.
- Independent Office: ONE broker not affiliated with a multi-state franchise.

VP of Business Practices (1-Year Term) (may serve 2 consecutive terms)

Candidates must be or have held the position of a SKCR or WR Director, and have served one year as a Business Practice, Grievance, or Professional Standards Committee member, or Sub-Committee or Task Force Chairperson, at the time the candidate would normally be sworn into office.

VP of Member Services & Communication (1-Year Term) (may serve 2 consecutive terms)

Candidates must be or have held the position of a SKCR or WR Director, & have served one year as a Member Services & Communication Committee member or Sub-Committee or Task Force Chairperson, at the time the candidate would normally be sworn into office.

VP-Elect of Governmental & Public Affairs (1-Year Term)

Candidates must be or have held the position of a SKCR or WR director, and have served one additional year as a Governmental & Public Affairs Committee member, or Sub-committee or Task Force Chairperson, at the time the candidate would normally be sworn into office. The VP-Elect succeeds to VP of Governmental and Public Affairs in the ensuing year.

President-Elect (1-Year Term)

The candidate must be or have been 1) an Officer of SKCR or 2) a SKCR Director who has also served as one of the following; a Standing Committee, Sub-committee or Task Force Chair-person of SKCR; or a Standing Committee member of SKCR for at least two years; or a Director of Washington REAL-TORS® for at least two years at the time the candidate would normally be sworn into office. The President-Elect succeeds to President in the ensuing year.
